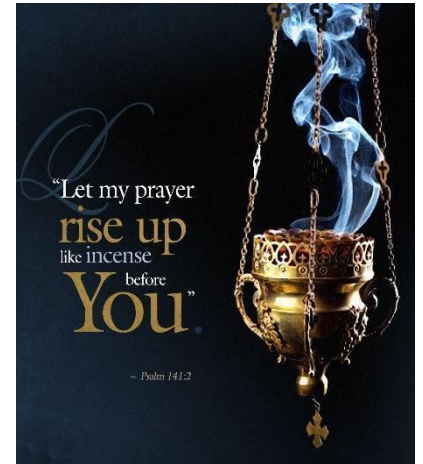
NOW THROUGH AUGUST: PLEASE bring in non-perishable food items for the Atlanta Community Food Bank Can drive. Thank you!

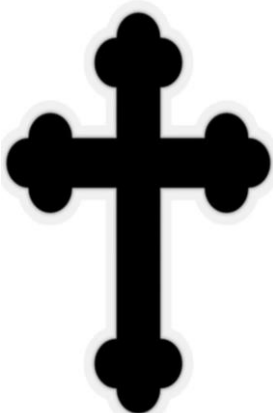


ZELLE! ZELLE! ZELLE! St. John Chrysostom can now receive donations via Zelle. Our “handle” (donation id) is donate@stjohnmelkite.org. Please put a note in the memo of any Zelle donation, such as “Weekly Support” or “Commemoration.” As this is new to the parish, please let us know if this is more convenient or if you prefer Venmo.

2nd Collection: The second collection in Church will now only occur for actual special collections (e.g., Holy Land, Ukraine, etc.). Hence, if you are late, please use the receptacle in the back of the church for donations. You may put them in the donation box as you exit at the end of Divine Liturgy.

TREASURE ACCOUNTING: Since July 1, 2022, the church has been using software to track donations, providing us with financial reporting to Eparchy and for Tax reporting requirements. If you give via cash, PLEASE use a donation envelope (found in narthex) with your name to record your family’s donation properly. We have many options (Bill pay, credit card, ACH and Zelle), so please contact us to help you setup what is most convenient.

WHAT ABOUT TRADITION? Yes, the fourth “T” of stewardship, as we have received the apostolic tradition and the Melkite Byzantine tradition as a gift from God. To be stewards of it, we must not only learn it and grow spiritually but share it - perhaps by inviting a friend to the Divine Liturgy or praying for others, including those in our Prayer Line.

----- SACRAMENTAL LIFE -----

HOLY MYSTERIES (SACRAMENTS)

Baptism, Chrismation & Eucharist: Ideally inform us during the 5th month of pregnancy for preparation of the Mysteries of Christian Initiation, administered together in our tradition.

Repentance/Confession/Reconciliation: Confessions normally are available towards end of Orthros. Please inform a Deacon or Usher, in advance, that you desire such. All should prepare themselves well to receive the Eucharist properly each time.

Crowning in Marriage: Please call us 1+ year in advance of an anticipated marriage, before you book a place for reception to complete the questionnaire/research and confirm availability.

Anointing with Holy Oil and/or Reception of Holy Eucharist and/or Sick Calls: By personal or family request for those who are ill at home/nursing home/hospital or by anyone anticipating a hospital stay/surgery. Contact a Deacon to acquire a priest.

ASCRPTION TRANSFER (CHANGE OF RITE): To formally join the Melkite Church, let us know as procedure has been updated.
